

Mr. Butler's Classroom Expectations for Seminar

1. Seminar is a class that must be attended. Be on time!!
2. Bring something to work on in class. Talking is not allowed. If you are not working in class, then work will be given to you to do! This is study time - study, do homework or read.
3. You are responsible for your behavior. Take care of it so that I will not have to do anything about it.
4. School rules must be followed. Read the student handbook.
5. Wear appropriate clothing to school. Also, wear it appropriately. Button the buttons, zip the zippers, wear no hats, and leave the clothes with inappropriate slogans at home.
6. Use appropriate language in the classroom.
7. BE TO CLASS ON TIME! You will be counted tardy if you are not in class when the bell rings. Do not play games with this or else it will be counted as inappropriate behavior in class and treated with equal discipline. All tardies will be turned in to the office following the guidelines in the student handbook.
8. If you need to go see another instructor, you will need to be signed out on **YOUR** agenda. Go to where you are signed to, conduct business, then return. Do not waste time in the hallway!!
9. No iPods, MP3 players or any other personal music devices are allowed. If I do see them, I will take them and you can negotiate with me at the end of the day for its return.
10. All students are to be back in class by the end of seminar. If you are late returning it will be marked down as a tardy.
11. Cell phones are not to be used in my classroom unless permission is given. Cell phones will need to be placed on the corner of the student's desk during class time. If phone usage does become a problem, then cell phones will be collected by the teacher at the beginning of the hour and then returned at the end of the hour. Any time that a cell phone is being used without permission given

beforehand, the cell phone will be taken and turned in to the office. If cell phone use becomes a persistent problem, the phone will be taken and discipline for failing to obey directions will be given.
